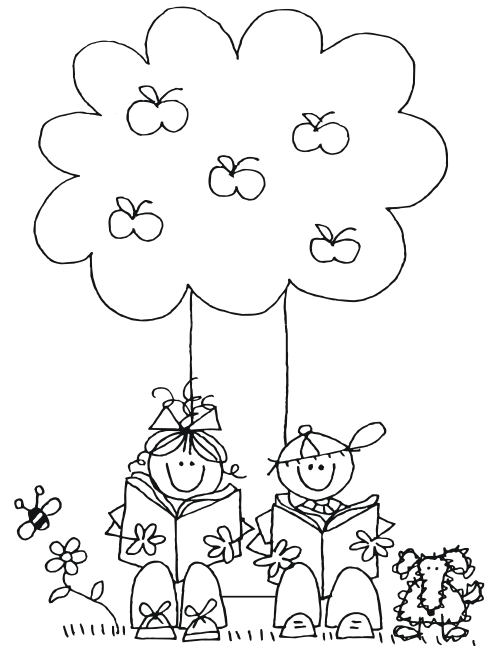


Pre-K Summer Reading List
