to the survivors of the Ecuador earthquake.

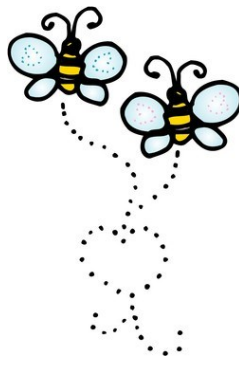
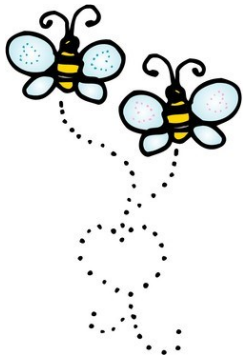
Our school will be collecting:
