Please help us provide some relief to the survivors of the Ecuador earthquake.


Our school will be collecting:

- Linens (bedsheets, throws, towels only in new or good condition)


Donations can be dropped off in boxes by the Main Office through **Friday**, **April 29**th. All items will be shipped to Ecuador soon thereafter.






