Sunset Elementary School INTERNATIONAL STUDIES MAGNET PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY AND ADMISSION PROCEDURES



Who is eligible to attend?

The International Studies Magnet Program offers French, German, and Spanish language for 1^{st} - 5^{th} grade. Any student that will be **six** on or before September 1^{st} and is enrolled in kindergarten is eligible to apply for the first grade. Students applying for 2^{nd} - 5^{th} grade need to have knowledge of the foreign language they are applying to. There is no beginner's level in 2^{nd} - 5^{th} grade.

What is considered to determine eligibility?

- Academic Grades
- Effort
- Conduct
- Attendance
- Readiness Test for incoming 1st graders and Foreign Language Proficiency Test for 2nd-5th grade applicants

When do I apply for admission to the magnet program?

Applications for the magnet program are accepted October 1st through January 15th. Applications received during this period will be considered for the next school year.

What will I need to submit with the application?

Complete the **Miami-Dade County Public Schools School of Choice & Parental Options** online application found at http://yourchoicemiami.org.

Application consists of the following:

- Student Information
- Family Information
- School Selection
- Upload Documents: Current Report Card from the 2016-2017 school year (1st Grading Period)
- Agreement of Understanding

What happens after I submit the completed application?

When you submit the completed application, you will select an appointment date to bring in your child and have him/her tested. Children entering first grade will be administered an entry Readiness Test and children applying for 2nd-5th grade will be administered a Foreign Language Proficiency Test and must be

proficient in the foreign language. Eligible students who meet eligibility criteria will be recommended to the program and entered in a random selection. Students who do not meet eligibility criteria will not be recommended and not entered in the random selection.

When will I know if my child is accepted to the magnet program?

Parents will be informed if the child has been accepted, on a waiting list, or not accepted by mid-March. Parents will have to accept/decline position by April.
