



Dear Parents:

Students in the French program learn to write in cursive and work with supplies and books that can only be imported from France as they are not available in the United States. The French International Program Association (FIPA), our not-for-profit parent organization, purchases and imports these items in advance in order to have them available at the beginning of each school year.

The cost of these items and shipping expenses is \$30.00 per child and includes:





National PTA® Reflections Official Rules



By entering the "National PTA Reflections Program," entrants accept and agree to be bound by these Official Rules as well as the entry requirements for their specific arts category and division. Any violation of these rules may, at PTA's discretion, result in disqualification. All decisions of the judges regarding this program are final and binding in all respects. (The "PTA" referred to in these rules include all PTAs reviewing the entry).

- 1. **ELIGIBILITY.** Students must participate through a local PTA/PTSA in good standing. Parent groups not affiliated with National PTA are not eligible to sponsor this program. It is the responsibility of the state and local PTA/PTSA to determine each student's eligibility in the National PTA Reflections Program. A student may develop an entry in or outside of school.
- 2. ARTS CATEGORIES. There are six arts categories dance choreography, film production, literature, music composition, photography and visual arts. Students may enter the National PTA Reflections Program in one or more arts categories. See each Arts Category Rules for additional entry requirements.
- 3. GRADE DIVISIONS. Students may enter in the appropriate division for their grade (Primary: Preschool-Grade 2; Intermediate: Grades 3-5; Middle School: Grades 6-8; High School: Grades 9-12; Special Artist: All grades welcome). If students do not fall under specific grade divisions, National PTA suggests they be grouped by age (Primary: Up to age 7; Intermediate: Ages 8-10; Middle School: Ages 11-13; High School: Ages 14+; Special Artist: All ages welcome). See Special Artist Division Rules for entry requirements.
- **4. HOW TO ENTER.** Entrants must submit their artwork and student entry form to their local PTA/PTSA program according to local and state PTA procedures. Entrants must follow requirements and instructions specific to each arts category and division. Contact local PTA programs for deadlines and additional information.
- 5. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS. (All participants must also follow Arts Category and Division Rules)
 - Only new pieces of artwork inspired by the current year's theme may be submitted.
 - Each entry must be the original work of one student only. An adult may not alter the creative integrity of a student's work. Because the program is designed to encourage and recognize each student's individual creativity, help from an adult or collaboration with other students is not allowed except in the Special Artist Division. Only one student may be recognized as the award recipient for each entry. Other individuals may appear in or perform a student's work, but the work itself must be the creative product of one student only. See the specific Arts Category Rules for details.
 - Each entry must contain a title and all entries must include an artist statement. The artist statement communicates what inspired the
 work, how it relates to the theme, and the content of the work. The statement must include at least one sentence, but may not exceed
 100 words.
 - Use of copyrighted material is prohibited, except for recorded music in dance choreography and film production entries.
 Plagiarized entries will be disqualified. Use of PowerPoint presentations are prohibited because most graphic elements are copyrighted.
- 6. FINALIST SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION. Entries are reviewed at local, regional, state and national levels. Each PTA determines its own judges for the program. Entries will be judged primarily on how well the student uses his or her artistic vision to portray the theme, originality and creativity. The National PTA Reflections program makes no restrictions on content or subject matter in artwork. Under no condition may parents or students contact the judges to dispute the status of any entry.
 - Awards are announced according to local and state procedures. Florida award recipients will be announced on the state website by March 31, 2017. National award recipients will be notified via email by National PTA on **May 1, 2017**. The PTA in its sole discretion will select finalists for exhibition and provide awards/prizes.
- 7. OWNERSHIP AND LICENSE. Ownership in any submission shall remain the property of the entrant, but entry into this program constitutes entrant's irrevocable permission and consent that PTA may display, copy, reproduce, enhance, print, sublicense, publish, distribute and create derivative works for PTA purposes. PTA is not responsible for lost or damaged entries. Submission of entry into the PTA Reflections program constitutes acceptance of all rules and conditions.
- 8. PARTICIPATING ENTITIES. This program is administered by the National Parent Teacher Association (PTA) and PTA affiliates.
- 9. FLORIDA PTA SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS. All PTAs/PTSAs must register on the National PTA (NPTA) Reflections database www.pta.org/reflections and report program data via NPTA database and printed copies as entries move forward. Florida PTA Forms A & B are required. Submission and uploading of all entries advancing are strongly encouraged. Submission of digital copies may be submitted on any media as long as the file is the proper format. See each Arts Category Rules for additional entry requirements.



National PTA® Reflections



Summary of Rules for Participation

Students must participate through a local PTA/PTSA in good standing and may enter in one or more arts categories. Only new pieces of artwork inspired by the theme may be submitted. Each entry must be the original work of one student only. Only one student may be recognized as the award recipient for each entry. Other individuals may appear in or perform a student's work, but the work itself must be the creative product of one student. Use of copyrighted material is prohibited, except for background music in dance choreography and film production entries when cited. Entries will be judged on how well the student uses his or her artistic vision to portray the theme, originality and creativity.



Dance Choreography. Accepted styles include solo/ensemble include: ballet, contemporary, ethnic and folk, hip hop, jazz and tap. Choreographer may be the perfomer, or one of the performers, but does not have to be. Video recording must not be less than 1 minute nor exceed 5 minutes and must be less than 1 GB (one gigabyte) in file size. Accepted file formats: AVI, FLV, WMV, MP4, or MOV, only.



Film Production. Accepted forms include: Animation, narrative, documentary, experimental, or a media presentation (PowerPoint is prohibited). Entrant must be the director, screenwriter, and camera person including all storyboarding and editing. Video recording must not be less than 1 minute nor exceed 5 minutes and must be less than 1 GB (one gigabyte) in file size. Accepted file formats: AVI, FLV, WMV, MP4, or MOV, only.



Literature. Accepted forms of fiction and nonfiction include: Prose, poetry, drama (screen play and play script), reflective essay, narrative, and short story. Entry must not exceed 2,000 words and must be handwritten or typed; one side only. Students for whom English is not their first language may submit literature entries in their own language. An interpretive translation in English must accompany the entry. Accepted formats: Single-sided handwritten on 8 ½ x 11 paper then saved as either a PDF (.pdf) or Word (.doc) file format OR typed then saved as either a PDF (.pdf) or Word (.doc) file format.



Music Composition. All instruments, sounds, styles and combinations are accepted. Copyrighted material is prohibited. The composer may be the performer, or one of the performers, but does not have to be a performer. Notation, score or tabulature is required for middle and high school division. Audio recording must not be less than 1 minute nor exceed 5 minutes. Accepted file formats: MP3, WAV, or FLAC formats. Music videos are **not** accepted as the work of art, but may accompany the audio file, for promotional purposes.



Photography. Accepted forms of photography include: A single photo, panoramic, photomontage (one seamless print of multiple original photos), a multiple exposure, negative sandwich or photogram. Original black-and-white and color images are accepted. Entrant must be the one to take the photograph. Must be at least 11x14 inches and not exceed 24x30 inches, including matting. Must be mounted or matted on foam board, or other sturdy material. Accepted formats include: Matted print, or high resolution digital photo (.jpeg, .jpg, .gif, .png, .bmp).



Visual Arts. Accepted forms include: Architecture (2D/3D), carpentry, ceramics, collages, photographic collages (multiple photos cut/pasted), computer-generated image, crafts, design, dioramas, drawing, fiber work, jewelry, kites, metal etching/punch work, mobiles, painting, printmaking, sculpture and wind chimes. Framed entries not accepted. Stretch canvas is accepted. Must be at least 11x14 inches and not exceed 24x30 inches, including matting. Paper entries must be mounted on form board or other sturdy material and 3D works must include packaging materials and 3 high resolution photos of the entry for judging and ID purposes (.jpeg, .jpg, .gif, .png, .bmp).
