Dear Parents/Guardians:

During the month of April, your son or daughter will take the Stanford Achievement Test, Tenth Edition (SAT-10). The SAT-10 is a standardized test given in the Miami-Dade County Public Schools to measure your child's achievement in reading and mathematics. Teachers use the results to plan units and lessons that strengthen students' skills, and to make sure that your child receives appropriate support and services. In addition, the SAT-10 is used to identify students eligible for District programs and to gauge the efficacy of District initiatives.

This year, the SAT-10 testing dates are April 5 and 6 with make-up days on April 7 and 8, 2022. It is important for your child to be present. This notice is being sent home so that you can note these dates on your calendar and avoid making appointments for your child that would cause him/her to miss taking the test.

Individual Student Reports will be provided in the fall of 2022-2023 school year. SAT-10 results are also posted on the Parent Portal as soon as they are available.
